

## **EXPLANATIONS**

### **on the application for national approval of recognition as an aeromedical examiner (AME) of another member state**

The aeromedical examiner approved in one EASA Member State may also perform his activities also in another EASA Member State under the following conditions:

1. the aeromedical examiner must hold a valid AME certificate issued in an EASA member state;
2. right to practice independently as a physician;
3. briefing by the Member State that received the application (training at the competent authority, audit at the location of the planned aeromedical practice);
4. the aeromedical examiner must meet the national professional requirements for the exercise of the medical profession.

## **FEES**

For official acts of Austro Control GmbH, fees are to be charged in accordance with the Austro Control Gebührenverordnung (ACGV, Federal Law Gazette II No. 2/1994, as amended).
