

EXPLANATORY NOTES

Application for a secondary review of the aeromedical fitness

If the Aeromedical Examiner determines that an applicant for a Medical Certificate does not meet the required medical fitness, the applicant and Austro Control GmbH as the competent authority shall be notified immediately ("Notification of Denial of Medical Certificate").

The applicant shall be prohibited from exercising the privileges and functions of the licence from the date of notification of unfitness by an AME.

If the applicant is still in possession of a valid medical certificate at the time of the assessment of unfitness, this medical certificate shall be withdrawn by the AME.

RIGHTS

After the notification of denial of a medical certificate, a reassessment of the required medical fitness by an Aeromedical Examiner is not permitted. However, the applicant shall have the right to apply to the competent authority for a secondary review of the aeromedical fitness within 4 weeks of the issuance of the notification of denial. All relevant medical reports and a statement of the reasons for the application for a secondary review shall be submitted to the Authority with the application. The applicant agrees that in the course of the secondary review all results from consulted specialists/experts may be forwarded for specific assessment and, if applicable, that medical reports may be returned directly to the authority (medical assessor of Austro Control GmbH).

FEES

For official acts of Austro Control GmbH, fees are to be charged in accordance with the Austro Control Fees Regulation (ACGV, Federal Law Gazette II No. 2/1994, as amended). The Austro Control Fees Regulation also prescribes a fee for the secondary review of the aeromedical fitness.

In addition, the payment of fees pursuant to the Fees Act 1957 (GebG) is provided for and these shall also be invoiced accordingly by Austro Control GmbH.

It should be noted that fees according to ACGV and GebG also accrue in case of application withdrawal.
