











<p><b>3-G Regel</b>  <b>G</b>etestet  <b>G</b>eimpft  <b>G</b>enesen</p>	<p><b>The 3-G Rule for Access to Austro Control Premises</b>                  Access to and entering Austro Control premises and locations is only permissible for persons who fulfil the stipulations of the so-called „3-G Rule“ (German: „Getestet, Geimpft, Genesen“ = „Tested, Vaccinated or Recovered“) thereby minimizing epidemiological risk. If no 3-G certification can be provided, persons on Austro Control premises may be granted access provided they wear FFP-2 masks for the duration of their stay. (Further details regarding the wearing of masks can be found below under “Wearing of Masks in the Absence of 3-G Certification”)</p>
	<p><b>Mandatory Wearing of Masks in the Absence of 3-G Certification</b>                  Wearing of FFP2 masks is mandatory indoors on all Austro Control premises:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• for persons who cannot provide a 3-G certification</li> <li>• for ACG staff in possession of 3-G certification who are in direct contact with clients/visitors who do not have 3-G certification or those whose 3-G status is unclear.</li> </ul> <p>Wearing of FFP2 masks is generally recommended. Appropriate regulations apply in operational workspaces.</p>
	<p><b>Keep your distance!</b>                  Keep a distance of at least 1 meter, if possible more than 2 meters, between yourself and all other people.</p>
	<p><b>Wash your hands regularly!</b>                  Wash your hands with soap and water, especially before eating and after contact with surfaces.</p>
	<p><b>Avoid shaking hands!</b>                  It is not rude not to shake hands. It protects against infection.</p>
	<p><b>Sneeze or cough into your elbow!</b>                  Sneeze or cough in the bent elbow or in a handkerchief. Dispose of used handkerchiefs.</p>
	<p><b>Don't touch your face!</b>                  Viruses can be easily transmitted to the mucous membranes of the mouth, nose and eyes via the hands.</p>
	<p><b>In the case of any symptoms: stay at home!</b>                  If you are afraid of being ill, please dial 1450. ACG locations may only be entered if there are no suspicious symptoms (cough, sore throat, headache, fever ...).</p>
	<p><b>Report a <u>confirmed infection</u> to Austro Control!</b>                  Report immediately if you are at an ACG location 48 hours before the first symptoms appear.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>→ For ACG employees, the following applies: Observe ACG reporting channels on the intranet!</li> <li>→ For external persons: Immediate notification to your ACG contact AND to <a href="mailto:asgm@austrocontrol.at">asgm@austrocontrol.at</a></li> </ul>
	<p><b>Strictly follow internal instructions!</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>→ Follow the access restrictions &amp; the special hygiene measures of the respective location.</li> <li>→ The following applies to <b>external persons</b>: If there are any discrepancies, you can be expelled from the location.</li> </ul>
	<p><b>Responsible Conduct at Home/in Private Surroundings</b>                  Responsible conduct in private surroundings contributes to our own health and the health of those around us. By doing so, we enable Austro Control to maintain operational activities as part of the critical infrastructure.</p>
