Safety advice amendment

Regarding to the Safety Advice on the safe transport of dangerous goods by air, issued on the 13th of March 2015, GZ: LFA-CC/DG 954-01/10-15, Austro Control GmbH refers to ICAO Addendum No. 1 (Doc 9284-AN/905 2015-2016 Edition Addendum No. 1 26/5/15) and the mandatorily adopted ICAO Part 8, Chapter 1, Table 8-1:

19) Battery-powered portable electronic smoking devices (e.g. e-cigarettes, e-cigs, e-cigars, e-pipes, personal vaporizers, electronic nicotine delivery systems)	allowed in checked baggage: NO allowed in carry-on baggage: YES allowed to be carried on the person: YES Approval of the operator(s) is required: NO The pilot in command must be informed: NO

Restrictions:

- a) carried by passengers or crew for personal use;
- b) spare batteries must be individually protected so as to prevent short circuits (by placement in original retail packaging or by otherwise insulating terminals, e.g. by taping over exposed terminals or placing each battery in a separate plastic bag or protective pouch);
- c) each battery must not exceed the following:
 - for lithium metal batteries, a lithium content of 2 grams; or
 - for lithium ion batteries, a Watt-hour rating of 100 Wh;
- d) each lithium battery must be of a type which meets the requirements of each test in the UN Manual of Tests and Criteria, Part III, subsection 38.3; and
- e) recharging of the devices and/or batteries on board the aircraft is not permitted.:

As a result of addendum No. 1 point 1 of the above mentioned safety advice becomes mandatory.
