The typical Leisure Pilot?





LPL – the concept

Article 7 of the EASA BR

- ★ Leisure pilot licence, covering non-commercial activities involving non-complex aircraft with a MTOM up to 2000Kg
- ★ LPL has to comply with ERs for pilot Licensing
- ★ Medical certificate may be issued by a GMP, if so permitted under national law



LPL – the concept

- The concept for the LPL
 - **★ 2 RM groups: FCL.001 and MDM.032 SG Licensing**
 - **★ MDM.032 SG Licensing started in April 2007**
 - **★ ToRs:**
 - input from A-NPA 14/2006 and comparison of national models
 - Propose a new concept for the regulation of aircraft tailored to the complexity of the aircraft, used in non-commercial activities and draft the associated NPAs for the licensing rules
 - «...lighter than JAR-FCL, innovative, agreeable and accessible...»

- Subpart B, Section 1 Common requirements
 - **★FCL.100 Minimum age**
 - 16 years
 - **★FCL.105 Privileges and conditions**
 - → Non-remuneration
 - → Non-commercial operations
 - → Within aircraft category
 - **★FCL.110** Crediting for the same A/C category
 - \rightarrow E.g. PPL(A) to LPL(A)
 - **★TK**
 - 4 common subjects crediting



- Subpart B, Section 2 Basic LPL (A)/(H)
 - **★FCL.105.BA/H Basic LPL Privileges**
 - Aeroplanes:
 - →SEP or TMG with a MTOM of up to 2000 kg
 - →1 Pax
 - → local flights
 - → Helicopters:
 - →SEP helicopters with a MTOM of up to 2000 kg
 - →1 Pax
 - → local flights



- Subpart B, Section 2 Basic LPL (A)/(H)
 - **★FCL.110.BA/H Basic LPL Experience and crediting**
 - → Aeroplanes 20 H flight instruction:
 - →10 H dual
 - → 4 H supervised solo
 - →3 H navigation
 - → Helicopters 35 H flight instruction:
 - →20 H dual
 - → 6 H supervised solo
 - →3 H navigation





LPL- general overview

Subpart B, Section 2 – Basic LPL (A)/(H)

★FCL.135.BA/H Basic LPL – Extension of privileges

- → The privileges are limited to the class or type until:
 - →Aeroplanes: 3 H dual
 - → Helicopters: 5 H dual
 - → Skill test (practical and theoretical)
- **★FCL.140.BA/H Basic LPL Recency requirements**
 - → Same as full LPL

- Subpart B, Section 3 –LPL (A)
 - **★FCL.105.A Privileges**
 - → 3 Pax
 - → Limitation to local flights disappears
 - **★FCL.110.A Experience and crediting**
 - → 30 H flight instruction:
 - →15 H dual
 - → 6 H supervised solo, with 3 H cross country
 - → Basic LPL(A) holder 10 H flight instruction (6/3)
 - → Crediting: 10% up to 6 H
 - **★FCL.135.A Extension to another class/type**
 - → Same as for Basic LPL

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- Subpart B, Section 4 –LPL (H)
 - **★FCL.105.H Privileges**
 - → 3 Pax
 - → Limitation to local flights disappears
 - **★FCL.110.H Experience and crediting**
 - → 45 H flight instruction:
 - →25 H dual
 - →10 H supervised solo, with 5 H cross country
 - → Basic LPL(H) holder 10 H flight instruction (5/1)
 - → Crediting: 10% up to 6 H
 - **★FCL.135.H Extension to another class/type**
 - → Same as for Basic LPL



- Subpart B, Section 5 –LPL (S)
 - **★FCL.105.S Privileges**
 - → (powered) sailplanes and TMG
 - → Pax only after 10 H PIC
 - **★FCL.110.S Experience and crediting**
 - → 10 H flight instruction:
 - →8 H dual
 - →2 H supervised solo
 - → 40 launches and landings
 - Crediting: 10% up to 6 H, 20 launches and landings



LPL- general overview

Subpart B, Section 5 – LPL (S)

- ***FCL.130.S Launch methods**
 - > Limitation to method used for skill test
 - Additional training for other methods logbook, by instructor
 - → To maintain each method: 5 launches in last 24 months
 - → Renewal: missing launches with instructor

★FCL.135.S Extension to TMG

- → Limitation to (powered) sailplanes Extension to TMG:
- → 6 H flight instruction:
 - →4 H dual
 - →1 solo cross country
- → Skill test



- Subpart B, Section 6 LPL (B)
 - **★FCL.105.B Privileges**
 - → Hot-air balloons / airships up to 4000 m³
 - → Gas balloons up to 1200 m³
 - → 3 Pax
 - **★FCL.110.B Experience**
 - → 16 H dual instruction
 - →10 fillings and 20 TO
 - → 1 solo flight



LPL- general overview

Subpart B, Section 6 – LPL (B)

★FCL.135.B Extension to another class

- → Limitation to class used for skill test (Hot-air & gas balloons / hot-air airships) Extension
 - → Flight instruction
 - → Skill test (practical and theoretical)



LPL- general overview

➤ Subpart B, Sections 3 to 6 — LPL

★FCL.140.X Recency requirements

- valid for life without a class/type rating
- → within the last 24 months always 3 options:
 - →certain amount of PIC flying time & T/O
 - less amount PIC flying time & training flight(s)
 - proficiency check

New:

At least once every 6 years a proficiency check!

PPL, SPL, BPL - the concept

- > The concept for the PPL, SPL, BPL
 - **★ 2 Subgroups of FCL.001: JAR Transfer & New Licences**
 - **★** For (A) and (H): transfer of JAR-FCL
 - * For other aircraft:
 - → ICAO Annex 1
 - → National requirements
 - Proposals of experts

- Subpart C, Section 1 Common requirements
 - **★FCL.200 Minimum age**
 - → 16 (SPL, BPL)/17 (PPL) years
 - **★FCL.205 Conditions**
 - Fulfil requirements for class or type rating
 - **★FCL.215 TK examination**
 - **★FCL.235 Skill test**



PPL, BPL, SPL - General overview

Subpart C, Sections 2 and 3 – PPL (A)/(H)

- **★FCL.205.A/H Privileges**
 - → Same as JAR-FCL
 - → New: possible to receive remuneration for the provision of flight instruction for the LPL and PPL
- **★FCL.210.A/H Experience and crediting**
 - → Same as JAR-FCL

- Subpart C, Section 5 PPL (As)
 - **★FCL.205.As Privileges**
 - → Similar to (A) and (H)
 - **★FCL.210.As Experience and crediting**
 - → Based on JAR-FCL
 - → 35 hours of flight time (max. 5h FSTD)
 - → 25 h dual including 5h cross country (35 NM)
 - → 3h instrument instruction
 - → 8h solo flight time
 - → BPL (HAA) -> PPL(As): 10% up to 5 hours

- Subpart C, Section 6 SPL
 - **★FCL.205.S Privileges**
 - to act as PIC of (powered) sailplanes and / or TMG
 - not carry pax unless completed 10h PIC
 - restricted to non-commercial until
 - → 75h PIC
 - →age 18
 - proficiency check
 - > possible to receive remuneration for the provision of flight instruction for the LPL and SPL



- Subpart C, Section 6 SPL
 - **★FCL.210.S Experience and crediting**
 - at least 10 hours as specified for LPL(S)
 - → LPL(S) -> SPL: full credit
 - credit 10% up to 6 hours and 20 launches
 - *FCL.220.S Launch methods
 - **★FCL.225.S Extension to TMG**
 - **★FCL.230.S Recency**
 - → All as for LPL(S)



PPL, BPL, SPL - General overview

Subpart C, Section 7 – BPL

★FCL.205.B Privileges

- → to act as PIC of balloons and hot-air airships
- restricted to non-commercial until
 - → 75h PIC
 - →age 18
 - proficiency check
- possible to receive remuneration for the provision of flight instruction for the LPL and SPL



PPL, BPL, SPL - General overview

Subpart C, Section 7 – BPL

★FCL.210.B Experience and crediting

- → Same as LPL(B) but within the same group (size related, see AMC)
- → LPL(B) -> BPL: full credit

★FCL.225.B Extension class / group

- → Class: same as LPL(B)
- → Group: 20h flight time & 3 instruction flights

★FCL.230.B Recency

→ All as for LPL(B)

AMC/GM to Subpart C

- **★**Syllabus theoretical knowledge for PPL
- **★**TK examination
- **★**Content of the skill test for the PPL
- **★Flight instruction** syllabus
- **★**Skill test for extension to commercial privilege (B) & (S)
- **★**Extension of privileges (B) class/group



PPL, BPL, SPL - General overview

- Subpart C summary:
 - *Follows JAR-FCL for (A) and (H), with a similar system for (As)
 - **★For (S) and (B), only one licence**
 - Privileges may be extended to commercial activities once certain requirements are met



> III. Additional ratings





Subpart I - Additional ratings

Created to allow continuation of some national qualifications that were not included in JAR-FCL

- ▶ Based on input received from NAAs and analysed by FCL.001 group
 - **★Some of the qualifications suggested were not included (ex: related to Annex 2 aircraft, or crop dusting)**



Subpart I - Additional ratings

★FCL.800 Aerobatic rating

- 40 hours PIC in appropriate category
- + theoretical knowledge instruction (see AMC)
- > 5 hours dual aerobatic instruction time
- Iimited to category until dual familiarisation



Subpart I - Additional ratings

*FCL.805 Sailplane / banner towing

- → 150/100 hours as PIC
- 40h of these in the relevant category
- + theoretical knowledge instruction (see AMC)
- → 10 dual instruction flights (see AMC)
- → for sailplane towing: 3 familiarisation flights



Subpart I - Additional ratings

★FCL.810 Night rating

- → Same as JAR-FCL 1 for (A), (As) and TMG
- Same as JAR-FCL 2 for (H)
- → For (S):
 - →50 hours flight time
 - →5 hours dual instruction at night
 - limitation to "local flights"
- → for (B):
- 2 instruction flights with T/O during the night / average time of 90 min



Subpart I - Additional ratings

★FCL.815 Mountain ratings

- privileges: wheel & ski /flights to and from surfaces designated by the authorities
- training course: TK & practical training
- → skill test
- + 12 month validity
- revalidation: 3 mountain landings or prof. check



Subpart I - Additional ratings

AMC/GM to Subpart I

- **★**TK and flight training
- **★**PPL(H) night rating course
- **★**Mountain rating skill test

Instructors

- Subpart J, Section 1 Common requirements
 - **★FCL.900 Instructor certificates**
 - → Special conditions for introduction of new aircraft
 - **★FCL.915 General requirements for instructors**
 - **★FCL.920 Instructor competencies and assessment**→ Draft NPA-FCL 36
 - **★FCL.940 Validity of the certificate**



Instructors

Subpart J, Section 2 – LAFI

- **★FCL.905.LAFI** Privileges and conditions
 - conduct flight instruction for:
 - → Basic LPL and LPL
 - →class or type extensions
 - night, aerobatic, towing rating
 - →LAFI certificate (experience / skill test)



Instructors

Subpart J, Section 2 – LAFI

★FCL.910.LAFI Restricted privileges

- flight instruction under supervision
- no first solo flights and solo cross country
- → limitations will be removed when:
 - →LAFI(A)/(H) 50 hours instruction / 25 solo flights
 - →LAFI(S) 15 hours or 50 launches covering the full syllabus
 - →LAFI(B) 15 hours or 50 T/O covering the full syllabus



Instructors

Subpart J, Section 2 – LAFI

★FCL.915.LAFI Pre-requisites for the course

- passing of a pre-entry flight test (with FI)
- → LAFI(A): 3 hours instrument instruction / 20 hours cross country / 200 (150) hours / 30 SEP
- → LAFI(H): 10 hours instrument instruction / 20 hours cross country / 250 (200) hours / 15 type
- → LAFI(S): 100 hours and 200 launches / for TMG: additional 30 hours on TMGs
- → LAFI(B): 75 hours on balloons / at least 15 hours in the class and group



Instructors

Subpart J, Section 2 – LAFI

★FCL.920.LAFI Training course

- → TK instruction and instructional techniques
- dual flight instruction:
- → LAFI(A) 15 hours (max. 3 hours FSTD)
- → LAFI(H) 25 hours (max. 5 hours FSTD)
- → LAFI(S) 10 hours or 20 launches
- → LAFI(B) 3 hours and 3 take-offs

★FCL.935.LAFI Skill test

Subpart J, Section 2 – LAFI

- *FCL.940.LAFI Revalidation and renewal
 - → Revalidation the instructor has to fulfil 2 of 3 requirements:
 - → Flight instruction
 - →refresher seminar
 - proficiency check
 - New: prof check every third revalidation
 - Renewal: refresher seminar & proficiency check

Subpart J, Section 3 – FI

★FCL.905.FI Privileges and conditions

- conduct flight instruction for:
 - →PPL, SPL, BPL & LPL
 - class- and type ratings / group extensions
 - ratings (experience / demonstration)
 - for FI / LAFI certificate (experience / skill test)
 - →and others as per JAR-FCL

Subpart J, Section 3 –FI

★FCL.910.FI Restricted privileges

- Flight instruction under supervision
- → Follows JAR-FCL for (A) and (H) similar system for other categories

★FCL.915.FI Pre-requisites

- → Follows JAR-FCL for (A) and (H) similar system for other categories
- → New: for FI(A) CPL knowledge is not mandatory

Subpart J, Section 3 –FI

★FCL.920. FI Training course

- **★FCL.935.FI Skill test**
 - → Follow JAR-FCL for (A) and (H) similar system for other categories

Subpart J, Section 3 – FI

- **★FCL.940.FI** Revalidation and renewal
 - → Revalidation the instructor has to fulfil 2 of 3 requirements:
 - → Flight instruction
 - →refresher seminar
 - proficiency check
 - →New: Prof check for the first and at least every
 - » Second revalidation for (A) and (H)
 - » Third revalidation for (As), (S) and (B)
 - → Renewal: refresher seminar & proficiency check
